RUBI Parent Training

The RUBI Parent Training for Disruptive Behavior curriculum supports families of children with confirmed or suspected autism ages 4-10 that are experiencing mild to moderate behavioral difficulties. This training focuses on teaching skills to parents and supporting implementation of those skills in the home.

Parents will learn how to:

- Respond appropriately to and prevent challenging behaviors
- Develop positive behavior strategies for teaching new skills
- Maintain structure and routines
- Practice functional communication
- Increase child cooperation with directions
